RULES AND REGULATIONS

Accepted art includes:

Painting, Drawing, Photography, Pottery, Sculpture, Ceramics, Digital Art, Jewelry, Leather, Metal, Wood, Mixed Media, and other Fine Crafts

- All applications to the Do Art in AC Atlantic City Boardwalk Art Show must be submitted by July 1, 2013.
- All work must be original work, created by the applicant.
- Applicant must submit by mail with his or her application, check for \$75 made out to: The Noyes Museum of Art and a CD with five (5) images of his or her original work, (1) image of the display and a bio statement about their work.
- The applications and CD will not be returned.
- The Atlantic City Arts Commission and The Noyes Museum of Art reserve the right to use images and bio statement in the advertising for the Show.
- The Atlantic City Arts Commission and The Noyes Museum of Art will review the work submitted with each application and notify each applicant whether their application has been approved no later than July 7, 2013.

- Each show space is 12' by 12'. Applicants may bring one 10' by 10' tent with proper weights and any other display racks. The Show will not provide tents or tables to artists.
- Artists are responsible for N.J. state sales tax ID #. For information, call the NJ Division of Taxation, (609) 292-1730.
- The Show rain date is Sunday, September 8, 2013.
- Set-up begins at 6:30am. Artists must break down and clean their space after 5pm.
- The Atlantic City Arts Commission, the Noyes Museum of Art and the City of Atlantic City are not responsible for any art or other items that are lost due to the artist's failure to break down his or her assigned space.
- Each artist must remain at his or her assigned space from 10:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. on September 7, 2013. No space shall go unattended during the hours of the Show.
- All cancellations must be submitted in writing to the Commission at least 72 hours prior to the Show. There are **NO REFUNDS** for cancellations.
- Creating on location is encouraged, however, no electricity is available or permitted during the Show. Artists are not permitted to bring gas powered electric generators.
- Each artist must enter the Boardwalk on the morning of the show during the time period and at the location listed on his or her notice of acceptance.

Neither the Atlantic City Arts Commission, the Noyes Museum of Art or The City of Atlantic City is responsible for lost/damaged work.
